We provide an inviting environment and skilled professionals in order to make your experience with us one to remember.



Ballet Students: Leotard, tan tights and pink ballet shoes without laces.

Male Ballet/Tap/Jazz Students: White shirt with basketball shorts and black ballet, jazz, and/or tap shoes.

Tap Students: Leotard, tan tights, tan tap shoes. (must order proper shoe through studio)

Jazz Students: Leotard, tan tights, spandex shorts or jazz pants, tan jazz shoe

Hip Hop Students: T-shirt, moveable bottoms (basketball shorts, sweatpants, leggings) and all black sneakers

Contemporary Students: Leotard, tan tights, spandex shorts or jazz pants, tan jazz shoe

Creative Movement Students: Leotard, tights, or movable clothing. Ballet shoes or socks with grips

Competition Students: Leotard, tan tights, spandex shorts, tan jazz shoe, hair in a ballet bun

Baton Twirling Students: Leotard, tan tights, spandex shorts or jazz pants, tan jazz shoe, baton ordered through studio

All students should arrive promptly for class. Tardiness results in disrupting the class and the student will not be properly warmed up for class.

STUDENTS MUST BE PROPERLY DRESSED FOR CLASS. ALL HAIR MUST BE UP OUT OF THE DANCERS FACE.

NO SCHOOL CLOTHES OR STREET SHOES ARE ALLOWED IN THE DANCE ROOM.



Tuition Payments

There is a nonrefundable \$35 annual registration fee for the insurance of your dancer. Registration is valid from September through August of that dance season.

Tuition payments are based on a yearly fee. You can either: pay in full for the dance year pay for half the year at a time pay monthly through monthly installments

The tuition rate is based on the amount of time that a student is dancing per week, not the number of classes they are attending. Once registered, parents will pay for first and last month's tuition. Afterwards, if you decided to pay monthly, I will be sending out reminder emails to parents and/or guardians before the next tuition payment is due. Monthly class tuition is to be paid on the dancers last class of the current month for the upcoming month. There will be a \$15.00 late fee for all payments made after the 15th of the month. Online, Cash, check or Venmo payments are accepted. All checks should be made out to Inspire Dance Centre. A convenience fee will be charged for card payments.

All studio accounts must be paid in full before any family members can purchase tickets to our end of the year recital.

2023-2024 Calendar

Inspire Dance Centre follows the Southold School District yearly calendar for vacations, some holidays, and some cancellations due to bad weather. Please check our Facebook page, the studio answering machine, or your email for class cancellations. If your child misses a class, they may make up that class by attending a different scheduled class within their age group other than the one your child is registered for. There are no refunds for missed classes.

Inspire begins its classes in September and are based on a 34-week year. 35- weeks are scheduled, which allows I extra week of classes. These extra classes are scheduled in case of any studio cancellations due to bad weather or other emergencies.

WINTER SHOWCASE

Each year, Inspire holds two shows. Our Winter Show is held in December and dancers are in at least 1 dance. All dancers must be registered by October 13th to be eligible to perform in our Winter Showcase. Our 2023 Winter Showcase theme will be Summer Vacation. Each female dancer will need a one-piece bathing suit, tan tights, and proper shoes. Male dancers will need an all black top and bathing suit bottoms. Hip-Hop female dancers will need a beach style top and all black bottoms. Parents are responsible to purchase and get these items. We will have a dress rehearsal week in studio the week of the showcase.

SPRING RECITAL

The dance year concludes with our dance recital either in the month of May or June. There will be a scheduled dress rehearsal before our dance recital that is held at the venue.

If you are unsure of your child participating in our Spring Recital you do not have to pay the annual recital fee of \$68.95. A decision must be made by December 15th and the full costume fee will be due at that time. Each style of dance your child takes requires a costume. These costumes are \$70.60. I select and order all costumes for my dancers. Costumes will not be handed out unless they have been paid in full. All costume fees are broken up into the first three months of the dance season (September-November). By December 15th, all costume balances must be paid in full or an additional \$20 late fee will be applied per costume.


